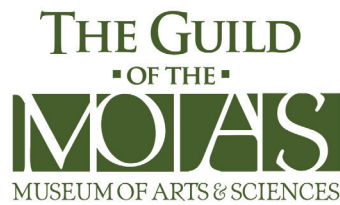
____ \$35.00 Active: A member who shall fulfill responsibilities in at least two of the following areas each year.
